Every Sunday at 4:00 p.m. from February 5<sup>th</sup> through June 4<sup>th</sup> there will be a Choral Evensong, a Service of Readings & Music, or a Concert at the Cathedral, except for the Sundays of April 16<sup>th</sup> (Easter Day) and May 21<sup>st</sup> (Victoria Day Weekend). On Sunday, March 26<sup>th</sup> the Choir of Hatfield College Chapel, Durham, UK, will be joining us for both the Evensong and 10:30 a.m. services that day. On Ash Wednesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, the King's College Chapel Choir will sing at the Cathedral's 5 p.m. Evensong and the Cathedral Choir will sing at the 7 p.m. Eucharist. Every Wednesday during Lent (March 1<sup>st</sup> through April 5<sup>th</sup>) the King's Chapel Choir sings Evensong at the Cathedral at 5 p.m.
